

# 2024 Policy & Procedures

DRAW classes- speed events, horsemanship, ranch riding, & reining
Order of Go: released by Wednesday, 8/21/2024 at 6 p.m.

CUT classes - all western rail classes

Multiple Cut Go: released by 7 p.m. the night before the class. Posted to/at: Website, Facebook, and exterior Show Office wall

\*for example: Sr. Ranch Rail will run Sunday evening. Their CUT go will be released at 7 p.m. on Saturday.

Contestant Back Numbers: stickers will have the contestant name and class number entered printed on them. Multiple CUT classes will say "cut released on this date at 7 p.m." Classes with a single cut will say 1.

SHOW OFFICE HOURS: 7:30 a.m. - 6 p.m.

Scratch forms & modifications to the class order of go due to a scratch are DUE by 6 p.m. the night before the class. Implementing this system along side the CUT class Order above allows us to ensure we are making the most efficient use of time and CUTS have the appropriate number of contestants to do so.

Scratch/Modification Forms: Notify Christy of all scratch/modifications ASAP prior to Thursday at the Luncheon - hardcopies will be due at this time for those made prior to the luncheon. Additional scratches/modifications made post 8/29/2024 @ noon will need to be handed to Christy directly.

#### **ARENA:**

4 minute time clock for all rail classes.

#### Lead Line:

Lead Line will compete as a single cut and the whole arena will be used. Exhibitors will enter down the center of the arena, showing to the judge as they travel. At the end of the arena they will be directed left or right and proceed down the given side, halting just before the one in front of them on the rail. Once all contestants are in the arena the announcer will direct to put right shoulder on the rail and proceed with the class accordingly.

Walk Trot 10 & Under, Pony Walk Trot, Pony Western Pleasure, & Gaited classes:

Contestants will enter the arena at a trot (or gait directed by announcer) and make the right turn to the rail and continuing along the rail and proceeding with the class as directed.

CUTS: \*There is NOT a designated order to enter the arena.

Western Rail Classes (*minus WT 10 & U, Pony WT, and Pony WP*) will enter down the center of the arena showing to the judges as they travel. At the end of the arena exhibitors will be directed left or right and will continue down the rail stopping just before the exhibitor in front of them on the rail and wait for further direction from the announcer (exhibitors right shoulder to the rail show at a \_\_\_\_.).

Western Pleasure Rail Classes: enter at the <u>TROT</u>
Jr. & Sr. Ranch Rail: enter at the EXTNEDED TROT

For classes with more than one CUT - Exhibitors will be dismissed and call back numbers announced in the back of the arena by the show manager.

### Final or Single CUTS:

Western Pleasure events with single/final cut - exhibitors will line up facing the "grandstand". Top 10 will be announced in random order and will proceed to the rail in front of them NOT THE FAR END, while all others will exit the arena. Top 10 placings will commence with awards being presented as shown at the X. \*See image on next page.

#### SPEED EVENT TOP:

When called back in enter down the alleyway and follow the rail down to the center remaining within the first half of the left wall

#### **PHOTOGRAPHY:**


Ryan Geiger Photography is the official and EXCLUSIVE 2024 ASCHSA photographer.

There is a backdrop located just behind Jim Mills trailer, in the breezeway between Cattle Barn 3 and 4. RGP will also have a photographer on the arena floor capturing all ASCHSA action shots and Award Presentations, as well as candid over the course of the weekend. Returning into the arena following exiting from awards is NOT allowed. Additional personal photography is to take place outside of the arena and alleyway. Prolonged standing within the alleyway for personal photo opportunists is prohibited.

Professional photography equipment and camera with lenses larger than 3 inches are not allowed. Professional photographers capturing image for sale, OR any persons mass capturing images for distribution on social networking sites are NOT allowed.







#### **Tractor:**

The tractor will remain in the arena for barrels, poles, and stake race. Tractors will be located in the corners by the alley way.

Reining:

Arena will be worked every 10 of exhibitors.

Pony Speed:

Arena will be worked every 2 associations.

Pony Flags:

Arena will be worked every 3 associations.

\*Aside from Pony Speed and Pony Flags all other speed classes the dirt will be worked after every association, regardless the number of entries.
